



Project Coordinator (cancer patients' employment outcomes)

We are seeking to recruit a highly motivated individual to lead a project investigating employment outcomes among cancer patients in Ireland.

The successful candidate must hold a primary or higher degree in a relevant subject (e.g. health or social sciences, epidemiology, health services research, health economics, etc). S/he must have at least 2 years experience in health-related research projects and experience of developing and implementing research study procedures. Database experience and well-developed data analysis skills are also required. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills are essential.

This is a specified purpose contract with an estimated duration of 3 years. Salary will be in accordance with Department of Health and Children grade V: €41,618 - €50,358 per annum. The post is based in Cork, Ireland. The post-holder will have the opportunity to spend some time working at Virginia Commonwealth University, USA.
