Molecular Medicine Ireland<sup>1</sup> has been funded by the Irish Higher Education Authority to develop a prestigious *Clinician Scientist Fellowship Programme* across five medical schools. The three year structured PhD programme builds on significant recent developments in the translational and clinical research infrastructure in Ireland. It provides an integrated approach to the training of the next generation of academic medical leaders to fulfil Ireland's needs in translational medical research.
